CAMROSE TROPHY - SEASON 2004/5

New Style Camrose.

The Camrose is now played over two weekends with all five countries attending. Each country will play two of the other four here and play the other two in Northern Ireland on 4th/6th March 2005. Scotland will be playing England and the Republic of Ireland this weekend.

Format.

Each country will play each opponent over four sessions of 16 boards with 32 boards comprising one match. Therefore each country will in effect play their opponents twice. Each session of 16 boards will take two hours followed by a 15-minute break to score up in imps. The second half of 16 boards will then be played – although not necessarily immediately – and again scored in IMPs. The two totals of IMPs will be netted off and converted to VP's according to the grid below.

At the end of the 5th session all countries will have played their first set of matches against the other two countries that they are due to play this weekend.

This process is now repeated between the 6th and 10th sessions when another two 32-board matches are played against the same two countries. As a result each country will have two totals of VPs scores against each opponent.

The league table will therefore show the results of this first weekend of the Camrose Trophy. The second weekend when each country play the two countries not played this weekend will complete the event and the country with the most VPs will win the Camrose Trophy.

Although the Camrose Trophy will not be decided until the Northern Ireland weekend there are a number of trophies being played for this weekend.

The **Pat Cotter Trophy** is awarded to the winners of the match between Scotland and England.

The **Billy Kelso Trophy** is awarded to the winners of the match between England and Northern Ireland.

The **Cupa Cairdeas** is awarded to the winners of the match between Scotland and the Republic of Ireland.

The **Cyfeillon Beiriste** is awarded to the winners of the Wales v Republic of Ireland match.
