


DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style, Responses, ½ Level, Reopening)
Style: Aggressive at 1 level, 2 level VUL will be sound
Responses: UCB. Fit jumps. New suit = F1
Reopening: May be stretched
1NT OVERCALL (2nd /4th Live; Responses, Reopening)
2nd position: 15-18
Responses: n As over opening 1NT
4th position: 11-14
Responses: As over opening 1NT
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style, Responses, Unusual NT)
Style: Roman, 5/5 in that suit and one above (excl. suit opened)
In principle sound playing values
Responses: limit raises, Cue = GF, 4 th suit natural and NF
Unusual notrump: Unusual
Reopening: 20-22 BAL
Respond as for opening 2NT
DIRECT and JUMP CUE BIDS (Style, Resp., Reopening)
Style: Michaels, 5/5, weak only. Jump cue asks for stop
If partner has bid - Jump cue = splinter
Responses: Suits NAT PRE, cue: sound raise
Reopening: Michaels
VS. NT (vs. Strong / Weak; Reopening; PH)
Strong & Weak: 2C=both majors, 2D=single-suited major 2H= H + minor, 2S= S + minor; X = pen.
Reopening: As above
Passed Hand: As above, X = both minors, 5/5 (5/4).
VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles, Cue-bids, Jumps, NT bids)
X = takeout
Over weak 2: X = takeout & Lebensohl responses
2 any NAT weak; Leaping michaels
2 NT 16 - 19 (Resp as for opening 2NT)
Defense to multi (see 2); defense to 2N 5/5m opener (see 3)
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS
vs strong 1♣: weak roman jumps (suit bid and suit above)
2C = clubs, 1D - 2D Michaels

DOUBLES
TAKEOUT DOUBLES (Style, Responses, Reopening)
Style: Emphasise M, m unclear
Responses: Cue F to suit agreement
Reopening: May be stretched
SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE DOUBLES
Most doubles to 4D are negative, unless one of us has shown interest in penalty, or after NAT bids over NT bidding, or if 2nd opportunity to double (& first opp would be neg). Responsive x to 4D, Game tries to 3S. Lightner. 3NT X = (1) Lead your suit (2) lead my suit, (3) lead dummy's suit

i.e. where opp X partners overcall, XX = Ax or Kx in overcalled suit.
- 2) DEF to multi:
 - 2nd**
X = 12/13-15 or 21+ pts (plus leb.)
2H/2S = natural, 5-6 card suit, 13+pts
2NT = 16-19 pts
3C/D = Nat Inv.
3H/S = roman jump, 5/5 in M and next suit up
3NT – to play
 - 4th**
X = 15-16pts, TO
Suit bids natural
3S = roman jump, 5/5 in s and c
2NT = 16-19 pts
 - 6th**
X = shapely TO
2NT = 5/5m
Cue asks for Stop
4 level – leaping Michaels
- 3) DEF to 2NT (5/5m)
3C = H & S (longer hearts) or equal length
3D = S & H (longer Sp.)
3H/S = NAT
- 4) INT(X): XX = undefined 5 card suit
2 any = lower of 2 four card suits
- 5) Lebensohl - In general 2NT is the weaker bid, direct bids to 3 level are GF. Over 1NT(2M) a direct cue bid shows a stop in their suit (showing 4 other M), direct 3NT shows stop in their suit...in both cases the same bids through 2NT deny a stop.
- 6) 1N-2S: inviting or better in clubs
1N-2N: inviting or better in diams
Then bid the trump suit, declines the invite = min (with or without support)
Break to intervening suit = max, but no trump support (ie not hxx)
Other bids (3M or 3N) are natural = max and agreeing minor hxx
